Referral Screening Tool: Completed by the Clinical Supervisor with the Student (Staff member)

As part of this course, student _____ (staff members name) will be supporting an individual in our service who is in need of Positive Behaviour Support. As this is a clinical piece of work, it is essential that the referral issue the individual presents with is suitable for the staff member (in that that they are a student learning about PBS) and also that the individual they will be supporting requires PBS. Also it is necessary that there is appropriate clinical supervision, support and governance in PBS available within the local service. This ensures that the quality of the casework delivered is in keeping with best practice guidelines , and also that the individual will be supported by the local PBS clinician both during and after the student’s participation in the Practice Certificate in MEBS with Callan Institute.
